

PENTECOSTAL ASSEMBLY OF FORT MCMURRAY RESPONDS TO HAITI CRISIS

A magnitude 7.0 earthquake devastated Haiti's kept populations centers on Tuesday, January 12, 2010. Thousands of structures; including residential properties, hotels, apartment complexes, office buildings, hospitals, etc have been completely levelled. An estimated 200,000 were killed and more than 2 MILLION left homeless.

The Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada's response organization(ERDO – Emergency Relief & Development Overseas) is already actively involved in the providing relief along with other international agencies, i.e. the Red Cross.
